Practice Stamp:

You have a duty of care to protect patients, colleagues and yourself by completing any required courses of vaccinations, to ensure you are immunised in accordance with the recommendations from the Department of Health.

In preparation for the assessment for fitness to clinical placement you *must* have received the following vaccinations (1 & 2):

- Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR) you are required to have documentary evidence of two MMR vaccinations. Most people will have received these in childhood. If you have not, your GP should provide these to you before the commencement of the course. You will need to provide your documentation as evidence of vaccination as GO Health cannot accept a verbal history of vaccination from you.
- <u>Tetanus, Diptheria, Pertussis and Polio</u> please ask your GP to ensure you are up to date with these vaccinations.

You may have received the following vaccinations. If you have not they will be carried out on commencement of course:

Hepatitis B Vaccination and Antibody Blood Test - Hepatitis B vaccination is given to ensure that students are protected from contracting this disease in the event of an exposure to blood and body fluids. This is a course of three immunisations. If you have received the course and a blood test to check immunity to hepatitis B please provide an identified and validated laboratory report.

<u>Tuberculosis (TB)</u> - please ask your GP to document whether you have been vaccinated with the BCG vaccine. Screening for possible TB is a requirement of your course and this will be arranged by GO Health Services.

<u>Varicella (Chickenpox)</u> - Please ask your GP whether you have had chickenpox. We require documentary evidence (if this is available) from your GP to confirm that you have had the infection. If you do not have documentary evidence of previous infection GO Health will take a blood test from you at the commencement of your course to confirm this before we provide you with vaccination to protect you against chickenpox.

Hepatitis B Surface Antigen, Hepatitis C Antibody and HIV Antibody - testing is mandatory for Midwifery and Paramedic Practice students. If you have not had the above tests GO Health will carry this out. Please take personal identification to your appointment (passport/driving license). GO Health are unable to pass you fit until these blood tests have been completed.
